We invite you to take part in the Christmas Tree Festival.

Here's what to do - it's simple...

This year's theme is "Anniversaries". This can be interpreted as widely as you like.

There are no rules, just a few guidelines.

- \* As an individual or as a group choose or make decorations for your tree.
- \* Trees can be real or artificial or not even Christmas trees at all, as long as they are vaguely tree-shaped. (Previously we have had a toy washing line and a decorated traffic cone and even a tree lying down in a swimming pool!)
- \* Please limit your tree to a height of about 4ft as space in the church is limited; many people use 3ft trees which may seem small but they hold a lot of decorations!
- \* We cannot supply electricity to trees so any lights you use must be battery-powered. Someone will turn them on and off for you.
- \* We will supply a name card to identify your tree. If you want to give your tree a title within the theme we'll put that on the card too.
- \* Please bring your tree to the church on Friday, 2nd December, between 4pm and 8pm either ready-decorated or join in the anticipation and excitement by decorating it there. Arrangements for collecting the trees after the festival will be made when you arrive.

Your support of this community event would be much appreciated. As well as bringing people together it raises money to help keep the church building, which exists for everyone, in good condition.

If you are a business then you may leave business cards or small leaflets with your tree.
